FIRST THESSALONIANS

- A. ^{1:1}Paul and Silvanus and Timothy
- B. To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
- C. Grace *to* you and peace

1A. ²We are giving-thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers

- 1B. Unceasingly ³remembering your work *of* faith and labor *of* love and endurance *of* hope *in* our Lord Jesus Christ, before our God and Father
- 2B. ⁴Knowing, brothers having been loved by God, your election, ⁵because—
 - 1C. Our good-news did not come to you in word only, but also in power and in *the* Holy Spirit and with great fullness-of-conviction—just as you know what-kind-of *men* we proved-to-be among you for your sake
 - 2C. ⁶And **you** became imitators *of* us and *of* the Lord, having accepted the word in much affliction with *the* joy *of the* Holy Spirit, ⁷so that you became *an* example *to* all the *ones* believing in Macedonia and in Achaia
 - 1D. ⁸For from you the word *of* the Lord has sounded-forth— not only in Macedonia and in Achaia, but in every place your faith toward God has gone-out— so that we *are* having no need to speak anything!
 - 1E. ⁹For they themselves are reporting about us *as to* what-sort-of entrance we had with you, and how you turned to God from idols
 - 1F. To be serving *the* living and true God
 - 2F. ¹⁰And to be awaiting His Son from the heavens, Whom He raised from the dead— Jesus, the *One* delivering us from the coming wrath
- 2A. ^{2:1}For you yourselves know our entrance to you, brothers— that it has not been empty
 - 1B. ²But having previously-suffered and been mistreated in Philippi, as you know, we were bold in our God to speak the good-news *of* God to you in *a* great conflict
 - 1C. ³For our exhortation *is* not from error, nor from impurity, nor in deceit. ⁴But just as we have been approved by God to be entrusted-*with* the good-news, so we speak— not as pleasing people, but God, the *One* testing our hearts
 - 1D. ⁵For neither did we at-any-time come with *a* word *of* flattery, as you know
 - 1E. Nor with *a* pretext *for* greed—God *is* witness
 - 2E. ⁶Nor seeking glory from people— neither from you, nor from others, ⁷[although] being able to be with weight as apostles *of* Christ
 - 2D. But we proved-to-be child-like in your midst
 - 3D. As when *a* nurse cherishes her children, ⁸in this manner longing-affectionately *for* you, we were well-pleased to impart *to* you not only the good-news *of* God, but also our *own* lives, because you became beloved *ones to* us
 - 2C. ⁹For you remember, brothers, our labor and hardship— working *by* night and *by* day so-as not to be *a* burden-on any *of* you, we proclaimed to you the good-news *of* God
 - 3C. ¹⁰You and God *are* witnesses how devoutly and righteously and blamelessly we were *with* you, the *ones* believing—¹¹justas you know how each one *of* you, as *a* father his *own* children
 - 1D. ¹²*We were* exhorting you and encouraging and testifying so-that you *might* walk worthily *of* God, the *One* calling you into His *own* kingdom and glory
 - 2B. ¹³And for this reason we are indeed giving-thanks *to* God unceasingly: because having received *the* word *of* God heard from us, you accepted not *the* word *of* humans, but, as it truly is, *the* word *of* God, which also is at-work in you, the *ones* believing
 - 1C. ¹⁴For you became imitators, brothers, of the churches of God existing in Judea in Christ Jesus, because you also suffered the same *things* by *your* own countrymen as they also by the Jews—
 - 1D. ¹⁵The ones also having killed the Lord Jesus and the prophets
 - 2D. And having driven us out
 - 3D. And not being pleasing to God
 - 4D. And *being* contrary *to* all people, ¹⁶ forbidding us to speak *to* the Gentiles in order that they might be saved

5D. So that *they* fill-up *the measure of* their sins always. But the wrath came upon them to the uttermost

- 3A. ¹⁷And we, brothers— having been orphaned from you for *a* season *of an* hour *in* face, not *in* heart— were more eager with great desire to see your face. ¹⁸Because we wanted to come to you— I, Paul, both once and twice— and Satan hindered us
 - 1B. ¹⁹For what *is* our hope, or joy, or crown *of* boasting— or *is it* not indeed you— before our Lord Jesus at His coming? ²⁰For **you** are our glory and joy
 - 2B. ^{3:1}Therefore, bearing *it* no longer, we preferred to be left-behind in Athens alone, ²and we sent Timothy, our brother and *a* fellow-worker *of* God in the good-news *of* Christ
 - 1C. So that *he might* establish you and encourage you concerning your faith, ³that no one might be disturbed by these afflictions
 - 1D. For you yourselves know that we are appointed for this
 - 2D. ⁴For even when we were with you, we were telling you beforehand that we were going to be afflicted, just as indeed it happened, and *just as* you know
 - 3D. ⁵For this reason, and I bearing *it* no longer, I sent *Timothy* so as to know your faith— *that* the *one* tempting had not somehow tempted you and our labor proved-to-be in vain
 - 3B. ⁶And Timothy having just-now come to us from you, and having announced-the-good-news *to* us *as to* your faith and love, and that you have *a* good remembrance *of* us always, yearning to see us just as we also you—⁷because of this we were encouraged, brothers, over you in all our distress and affliction, through your faith
 - 1C. ⁸Because now we live!— if you are standing-*firm* in *the* Lord
 - 2C. ⁹For what thanksgiving can we return *to* God for you for all the joy *with* which we are rejoicing because of you before our God?—
 - 1D. ¹⁰Praying super-abundantly *by* night and *by* day that *we may* see your face and complete the *things* lacking *from* your faith
 - 4B. ¹¹Now may our God and Father Himself and our Lord Jesus direct our way to you
 - 1C. ¹²And may the Lord cause you to increase and abound *in* love for one another and for everyone (just as we also for you), ¹³so that *He may* establish your hearts *so as to be* blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming *of* our Lord Jesus with all His holy *ones*. Amen
- 4A. ^{4:1}Finally then, brothers, we ask you, and exhort in *the* Lord Jesus that just as you received from us how you ought-to be walking and pleasing God (just as you also are walking), that you be abounding more. ²For you know what commands we gave *to* you through the Lord Jesus
 - 1B. ³For this is *the* will *of* God—your holiness
 - 1C. That you be abstaining from sexual-immorality
 - 2C. ⁴That each of you know-how to acquire control of his own vessel in holiness and honor, ⁵not in the passion of desire as indeed the Gentiles not knowing God
 - 3C. ⁶*That* no *one* overstep and exploit his brother in the matter
 - 4C. Because the Lord is the avenger concerning all these things, just as we also told you before, and solemnly-warned
 - 1D. ⁷For God did not call us for impurity, but in holiness
 - 2D. ⁸So-therefore the *one* rejecting is not rejecting *a* human, but God, the *One* also giving His Holy Spirit to you
 - 2B. ⁹But concerning brotherly-love, you have no need *that anyone should* be writing *to* you
 - 1C. For you yourselves are God-taught so-that you might be loving one another
 - 2C. ¹⁰For indeed you are doing it toward all the brothers in all Macedonia
 - 3C. But we exhort you, brothers, to be abounding more, ¹¹and to be ambitious to be quiet, and to be doing *your* own *things* and working *with* your own hands, just as we commanded you
 - 1D. ¹²In order that you may walk properly toward the *ones* outside and may have need *of* nothing
- 5A. ¹³And we do not want you to be unaware, brothers, concerning the *ones* falling-asleep, in-order-that you may not grieve as indeed the others— the *ones* not having a hope
 - 1B. ¹⁴For if we believe that Jesus died and rose-up, so also God will bring with Him the *ones* having fallen asleep through Jesus

- 1C. ¹⁵For we say this *to* you by *the* word *of the* Lord, that **we** the *ones* living, the *ones* remaining until the coming *of* the Lord— will in-no-way precede the *ones* having fallen asleep
 - 1D. ¹⁶Because the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shouted-command, with a voice of an archangel, and with a trumpet of God
 - 2D. And the dead in Christ will rise-up first
 - 3D. ¹⁷Then we— the *ones* living, the *ones* remaining— will be snatched-up together with them in *the* clouds to meet the Lord in *the* air
 - 4D. And so we shall always be with the Lord
- 2C. ¹⁸So then, be encouraging one another with these words
- 2B. ^{5:1}But concerning the times and the seasons, brothers, you have no need *that anything should* be written to you
 - 1C. ²For you yourselves accurately know that *the* day *of the* Lord comes in this manner—like *a* thief in *the* night
 - 1D. ³When they are saying "peace and security", then unexpected destruction suddenly-comes-upon them, just as the birth-pain *on* the *one* having *a child* in *the* womb. And they will by no means escape
 - 2C. ⁴But you, brothers, are not in darkness, so that the day should overtake you like *a* thief
 - 1D. ⁵For you all are sons of light, and sons of day. We are not of night, nor of darkness
 - 3C. So then, let us not be sleeping like the others, but let us be keeping-watch and being sober
 - 1D. ⁷For the *ones* sleeping are sleeping *at* night. And the *ones* getting-drunk are-drunk *at* night
 - 2D. ⁸But let **us**, being *of the* day, be sober
 - 1E. Having put on *a* breastplate *of* faith and love
 - 2E. And *a* helmet— *the* hope *of* salvation
 - 3D. ⁹Because God did not appoint us for wrath, but for the obtaining of salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ—
 - 1E. ¹⁰The *One* having died for us in order that whether we are keeping-watch or sleeping, we may live together with Him
 - 4C. ¹¹Therefore be encouraging one another, and building-up one the other, just as you are also doing
- 6A. ¹²And we ask you, brothers, to know the *ones* laboring among you and leading you in *the* Lord and admonishing you, ¹³and to be esteeming them super-abundantly in love because of their work. Be living-in-peace among yourselves
- 7A. ¹⁴Now we exhort you, brothers—
 - 1B. Be admonishing the disorderly *ones*, be encouraging the fainthearted *ones*, be holding-on-to the weak *ones*, be patient with everyone
 - 2B. ¹⁵See *that* no one gives-back evil for evil *to* anyone, but always be pursuing the good, both for one another and for everyone 3B. ¹⁶Be rejoicing always, ¹⁷be praying unceasingly, ¹⁸be giving-thanks in everything. For this *is the* will *of* God in Christ Jesus for
 - you
 - 4B. ¹⁹Do not be quenching the Spirit, ²⁰do not be treating prophecies with contempt, ²¹but be testing all *things*
 - 5B. Be holding-on-to the good, 22 be abstaining from every form *of* evil
 - A. ²³Now may the God *of* peace Himself sanctify you wholly. And may your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blamelessly at the coming *of* our Lord Jesus Christ
 - 1. ²⁴Faithful is the One calling you, Who also will do it
 - B. ²⁵Brothers, be praying also for us
 - C. ²⁶Greet all the brothers with a holy kiss
 - D. ²⁷I adjure you by the Lord that this letter be read to all the brothers
 - E. ²⁸The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you
